Important Information for the 2008-2009 School Year



1. When is the first day of school and what are the hours?

Our first day of school is **Wednesday, August 13**. School starts at 8:00am but students who arrive earlier than 7:30am will go to before care for an additional fee. Students who arrive at 7:30am will go to the sanctuary where they will be supervised and wait for their teachers to escort them to their respective classrooms. Students may purchase breakfast snacks for the **SGA/Student Government Association**. **Please purchase a SGA debit card. Please note that at 8:00am all classroom doors will be locked. Any student arriving after 8am must check in at the front office. It is imperative students arrive at school on time to keep down interruptions in the classroom along with safety of the students. PreK4 and Kindergarten classes will be dismissed at 2:45pm. Grades 1st - 6th will be dismissed at 3:00pm.**

2. What is Orientation?

Orientation is an information session in which parents have an opportunity to become familiar with the school's policies, rules, and guidelines, as well as an opportunity to meet the HPA Faculty & Staff. Orientation also updates you on any current changes and what we are offering this school year. All parents are expected to attend. **Orientation will be held on Monday, August 11th.** We will start **promptly at 7:00pm** in the church sanctuary therefore; doors will open at 6:30pm. The meeting should last no longer than an hour. You can purchase the **HPA** uniform and P.E. shirts, along with meeting your child's teacher. Remember this is not the time to ask the teacher a lot of questions, another date and time has been planned for you to "**Get to know Your Child's Teacher**". 3. Get to Know Your Child's Teacher Meeting:

This is a time to get to know your child's teacher early in the year without having to rush during Orientation. You will become familiar with room procedures, curriculum, and discipline measures. During this time you can also sign-up to be a Grade Mom or Dad. Mark your calendar for this date: **August 19th, 2008 - 7:00pm meet in the main sanctuary.**

4. When should I pay the following: Student Resource Fee, New Student Enrollment Fee and Tuition ?

Your resource fee is due July 25th and new student enrollment fees are due upon enrolling your child. Your tuition is due August 1. Like last year you can have your tuition drafted, but you must inform Vanessa Parson, HPA financial secretary ASAP. Even though it was drafted last year, you will have to let her know what your options are for the 2008-09 school year. There are no additional fees for computer lab, chorus, and art.

5. How will I be informed of menus, field trips and upcoming events?

We will use 4 ways to communicate to you - monthly newsletter, our **WEB** page on www.harvestpreparatory.org, e-mail, and letters to parents. It is imperative that you keep the main office updated of your e-mail address. Please call today if your e-mail address and or physical has changed or if we don't have it.

6. Grandparents' Day

This is an exciting time for the students and the grandparents. Grandparents travel to be a part of this important day in their grandchild's life. We firmly believe in family and have set aside Grandparents' Day to celebrate the institution of Gods' Family. The family is the foundation of all human society. This is one of our favorite days at HPA so mark your calendar for **Friday, October 24, 2008**. Students may invite a very special person if the Grandparent are unable to attend. There are scheduled events which will include an informal coffee/tea session, lunch, a program in the sanctuary, time in the classroom and a photo with your child. Grandparents' Day is for all students and their **VIP guest**. **Please invite your love ones today.**

7. New Resource Business Directory

What is it and how can I get into the directory?

It is our desire that we support all of the business owners at CCC and HPA. This will answer all your questions about good business owners such as an insurance agents, doctors, electrician, contractors, etc. You will be able to find everything you need in this directory. Miss Dionne Hall has volunteered to put together this resource directory. The directory will allow us to have a pool of **Christian business people** to choose from. The listing fee for Business owners is \$30. The cost will cover the layout/design in the directory for the 2008-09 school year. We will print and distribute the resource directory to the families of HPA and CCC.

8. New this year ("PREP CARDS")

Prep Cards are our selected restaurant discount card. It is our 1st Annual Fundraiser. We all enjoy eating at our favorite restaurants and these cards will save on your meals. Tell your friends about them. We would like each child to sell a minimum of 10 cards at \$10.00 each. The question may come to mind, can I sell more? Of course, you can! Do I have to sell? No, but we would like for you to assist us in raising funds for the academy. Remember you can give them away as gifts. The first time you use the card it pays for itself.

9. The Academic Clubs: What are they?

We are offering 3 new academic clubs this year. They are the Reading Club, Math Club, and the Science Club. You must register your child to be a part of these clubs. The reading club will meet weekly to discuss the chapter that has been assigned and get their new assignment. Books will be selected by the standards set by the Club Committee. There will be monthly outings for the Reading Club. This club is for 3rd -6th grade students. You will find out more about this club at Orientation. The Math Club will meet weekly. This club is designed to enhance students math skills. The Science Club will complete science projects and will be judged on different categories. More information will be shared at Orientation. You can register your child for one or more of these clubs. Presently, the Clubs will be meeting after school. Is there a fee to join? No, there is no fee to join, but all parents may have to purchase any material that may be needed for your child, e.g.: pencils, book, pens etc.

10. Our New Dress Code

Yes, we are in the 1st phase of our dress code for **Harvest Preparatory Academy**. The majority of the information is updated in the 2008-2009 Student Handbook-you will receive a copy at Orientation. Our dress code is to set a standard and bring forth uniformity. The dress code will also assist both the parent and the teacher. All polo shirts and P.E. t-shirts must be purchased from the **Harvest Store**.

- **Girls: Navy bottom (Modest length skirts, skorts, slacks, or shorts) and a HPA polo for girls with black, brown, or navy school shoes.**
- **Boys: Navy bottom and a HPA polo. The boys may wear cargo shorts or long pants. No jeans, overalls, or cut off pants. Black, brown, or navy school shoes.**
- **Chapel Attire—Girls: navy skirt or pants, white HPA polo, white or navy tights or socks, and black or navy shoes. Boys: Navy pants, white HPA polo, navy blue or white socks and black or navy blue shoes.**
- **PE Attire - Burgundy or gray t-shirts with blue shorts or blue athletic pants.**
- **All students must tuck in their shirts at all times. Boys are required to wear belts with the exception of P.E.**

11. Where and when can I purchase my child's school shirt?

Starting July 23, the Harvest store will be open to purchase shirts. **Please note that all school shirts must be purchased from The Harvest Store.** The store hours are 9am -4pm until school starts. Shirts will also be on sale at Orientation. Once school starts on August 13th, the store will be open daily.

12. Lunch

Lunch can no longer be charged to your account this school year. If you think your child will be eating lunch at anytime please purchase a lunch debit card. All other students who eat in the cafeteria frequently can start purchasing their lunch debit cards now or wait until Orientation. You may put any amount on your child's lunch debit card. Sometimes students forget their lunch and of course we will let your child eat. However, your account will be charged for emergencies like this. In the event if this should happen you will be notified by the accounting office so you can clear your account. Outstanding balances of 2 days or more will no longer be allowed. Thank you so much for your cooperation and understanding. It is our desire to be good stewards of what God has blessed us with.
